DIGITAL BROS: **SIGNED AGREEMENT WITH CAPCOM**

Through its division Halifax, Digital Bros will exclusively deliver in Italy ten new titles from Capcom, an international leader in videogames. Among the most expected games: "Devil May Cry™ 4" and "MotoGP 07"

Expected revenues: € 6 million for the fiscal year 2007/2008

Milan, May 2nd 2007 - **Digital Bros**, the Italian game entertainment company listed in the TechStar segment of the Milan Stock Exchange, **announces today to have signed an important agreement with Capcom**, one of the most popular international videogames' publishers and developers, for the distribution in Italy of a new successful videogames' series.

Due to the agreement, **Digital Bros will hold the exclusive right for the distribution through Halifax**, its division responsible for the videogames' localization and distribution on the Italian market, **of ten of Capcom's most expected titles** for the consoles: Xbox 360™ video game and entertainment system from Microsoft, PlayStation® 3, PlayStation® 2, PSP® computer entertainment systems from Sony, Nintendo DS™ and Wii™ video game systems from Nintendo® and PC.

Specifically, on the Italian territory there will be delivered the eagerly awaited **Devil May Cry™ 4** – the fourth chapter of the successful saga, developed for the new platform PlayStation® 3, Xbox 360™ and PC - and **MotoGP 07**, the official videogame for PlayStation® 2 based on the world championship of the most exciting motor sport on the planet.

Following the management forecasts, **the agreement with Capcom will have an impact of at least € 6 million on the annual revenues for the fiscal year 2007/2008** (1.07.2007 – 30.06.2008).

Listed on the Milan Stock Exchange since October 2000 and in the TechSTAR segment as from April 2004, the Digital Bros Group is the largest video game distributor in Italy and one of the leading distributors in the European market.
