Digital Bros has signed a supply contract with Verio, a fully owned subsidiary of NTT Communications and a leader in global IP solutions, for the Internet infrastructure of Horizons.

Investments amounted to Euro 2,5 millions of Euro

Digital Bros, a digital entertainment Group listed on the Nuovo Mercato of the Italian Stock Exchange, has signed a supply contract with Verio Europe, for the Internet infrastructure of Horizons, the most innovative and expected online massive multiplayer role play game.

Digital Bros, through its subsidiary Game Network, is in charge in Europe to manage the online component of Horizons, a next generation online 3D game which allows its users, through a monthly subscription fee, to interact with thousands of other players. Thanks to this contract, the Horizons online gaming community will count on an high quality technological infrastructure supplied by the world's largest telecommunications company.

Digital Bros forecasted that investments will amount to 2,5 millions of Euro in a 36 months period.

The launch of the Horizons commercial service in the European market is expected before the end of 2003. The game, now in a beta testing phase, according to Digital Bros management, will be able to attract more than 100,000 paying users in the first three months after the launch of the pay to play service generating revenues of 15 millions Euro in a period of 18 months.
